1. Complete and submit Milwaukee/NARI Foundation Scholarship Application
2. Documentation of approval from NARI National to sit for an exam
3. Demonstration of financial need (see section below on application)
4. For Employees: Two (2) standard letters of recommendation, or  
For a Company Owner: Two (2) letters of recommendation from contractors or business associates.
5. Cover letter
6. List individual accomplishments and recognition (awards, etc.)
7. Pre-register for a study group conducted at Milwaukee/NARI (10-week study group beginning in September 2010)
8. Recommendation from Study Group leader regarding participation (to be obtained at the end of the ten weeks of study group meetings)
